

CHS OOMPAH MUSIC BOOSTER MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, January 19, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Peggy Sorenson, OOMPAH President. There were approximately 19 attendees.

SECRETARY'S REPORT (Jeanne Jacobson)

- The November 15, 2016, meeting minutes were approved with one correction.

TREASURER'S REPORT (Michelle Rasmussen)

- The budget and expense reports were presented and approved.
- OOMPAH's status as a nonprofit organization is up to date.
- Several students owe fees for concert attire and marching band. Michelle will send letters to the students' homes requesting payment. Any unpaid fees will become an obligation for graduation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Papa John's Fundraiser (Anisha Goyal) – Students have sold 45/100 cards. All money or cards must be turned in by the end of February. A suggestion was made to advertise on the daily CHS announcements and include the order form on the OOMPAH website.
- Cabaret (Melissa Ramos) – Cabaret is scheduled for February 11 with a Mardi Gras theme. Carrabbas is catering and proposed a charge of \$5 per person in exchange for advertising opportunities. Melissa will check on obtaining access to the kitchen, which may require paying an additional facility fee. Kim Fennington offered to send out a sign-up genius to request volunteers. Mrs. Kurtz ordered flyers and order forms from Vista Print for \$40.00. It was agreed to limit ticket sales to 170 seats. Money will be collected outside the choral room during lunch on Jan. 23, 25, and 31 and Feb 2 and 3. CHS Art National Honor Society members are helping with decorations.
- White House Ornaments (Kim Piasecki) – All 150 ornaments were sold and all payments made in full.

TEACHERS' REPORTS

- **Choral (Ms. Kurtz)**
 - Three choral students were selected for All State Chorus.
 - Bella Voce has been invited to sing at the University of Maryland on March 4.
 - The December caroling outings were a success. OOMPAH received \$150 from Rio even though the second day of performance was canceled due to weather.
 - Boston trip—116 students & 6 adults registered. Packets will be distributed to students next week.
- **Instrumental (Mr. Orifici)**
 - Mrs. McNeal thanked OOMPAH for the very generous donations for C3.
 - The December Coffee House event was a big success. Mr. O may need additional chaperones for future events.
 - Two instrumental students made All State.
 - The Pit is rehearsing for the spring musical. The new safety net is working out very well.
 - Mr. O and Mrs. Kurtz are visiting cluster middle schools to recruit students for the music program next year.

NEW BUSINESS/PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Peggy Sorensen)

- OOMPAH did not make any money on the Organo Gourmet Coffee and Tea Fundraiser. It was agreed not to repeat the fundraiser next year.
- The end of year picnic will be held on May 21 at Ridge Road Park.
